
UK Innovation Survey 2015



In 2012-14, more UK businesses were innovative than in 2010-12

53% of all businesses were innovative

2. Either product OR process innovator


Innovative businesses are more likely to export, employ more qualified staff, and 40% collaborate to innovate, mostly with industry
