Interchange

Providing systems that allow our members to be better connected and gain broad experience.

This theme is about allowing our scientists and engineers to connect and gain experience and knowledge from **across government, industry and academia**.

To make interchange easier, we want to standardise how sectors, departments and professional institutions refer to and capture their expertise. We also want to support and grow secondment programmes that currently work, like **STEM Futures**, which has placed 8 people so far in industry placements with reduced effort for departments using a useful framework.
