



Creative Worker visa concession: Immigration clearance to enter the United Kingdom (UK)

Persons who hold a valid Certificate of Sponsorship on the Temporary Work - Creative Worker route, do not otherwise require a visa and wish to enter the UK from Ireland to undertake paid, temporary engagements require an immigration permission (“leave to enter”) which permits paid, temporary engagements under the Immigration Act 1971 (as amended). Such a person may use this form to apply for leave to enter the UK. Such a person should not use this form unless they plan to undertake paid, temporary engagements; otherwise their entry is directed by the Immigration (Control of Entry Through the Republic of Ireland) Order 1972 (as amended).

This form may be completed electronically. You are required to complete Part 1, Part 2 and Part 4 of the form. Part 3 is only to be completed if a third party will act on your behalf in respect of this application. You should not complete Part 5. You should then submit the form to the Border Force email inbox BFTier5C@homeoffice.gov.uk. Forms must be submitted at least 72 hours prior to arrival. On receipt of the form Border Force will consider your application. If Border Force grants you leave to enter the UK, this form will be appropriately endorsed and returned to you. Your passport will not be stamped. You should retain the form at all times alongside your passport as evidence of your immigration permission to enter and stay in the UK.
