<i>RA 3132 – An update to the guidance material for when an ATM equipment modification should be considered significant. This ensures RA 3132 maintains coherence with the revised RA 3134.</i>
<i>RA 3134 - Release into Service Strategy. A new regulation to confirm that at a project’s outset, stakeholders have identified all applicable requirements to successfully complete the Release into Service Process (RiSP) and ensure the ATM Equipment is fit for purpose and safe to operate.</i>
<i>Modification Classification. An update to the AMC for determining whether an equipment</i>

modification should be subject to the RiSP. Equipment Acceptance Board / Site Specific Acceptance and Commissioning Board. Update and clarification of each Board's role and responsibilities.

MAA Form 1430 – A new form for the RC to seek MAA approval for ATM equipment modifications, which are considered simple and low risk, to be classified as minor and thereby not subject to the Release into Service Process as referred to in RA 3134.

RA 3201 – An up-issue post the Sep 2021 release due to further NPA comments becoming evident. Change marks haven't been removed and additional change marks added in Para 10.

RA 3202 – An up-issue post the Sep 2021 release due to further NPA comments becoming evident. It has been left as a substantial rewrite therefore, no change marks are evident. There is an addition of a footnote to MAA 02 in RA 3201(1) Regulation in order to assist the RC with compliance.
