The Commission on Human Medicines is looking to appoint one expert and one lay member to the Clinical Trials, Biologicals and Vaccines Expert Advisory Group.

The Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency enhance and improve the health of millions of people every day through the effective regulation of medicines and medical devices, underpinned by science and research. The CTBV EAG is an independent advisory committee of the CHM that provide impartial advice to Ministers on matters relating to the regulation of medicines and medical devices. The CTBV EAG membership includes a wide range of highly skilled professionals who are senior and well regarded in their respective fields and lay representatives.

As a member of the Committee, you will possess or develop a working knowledge and understanding of the UK medicines regulatory procedures and be able to speak on a range of relevant issues. Members of the committee are required to consider, comment and contribute by drawing on their own individual clinical and academic expertise and judgement to frame clear advice to CHM or MHRA.

Expertise Required

- Nephrologist or Rheumatologist, with an interest in autoinflammatory diseases /amyloidosis. Clinical Nephrology /Clinical Rheumatology
- Lay member

Essential Criteria

The Member must be able to demonstrate the qualities, skills and experience to meet all the essential criteria for appointment.

Professional Member

- Have previous or current experience of committee membership
- Be a skilled communicator
- Be able to assimilate complex scientific information at short notice
- Be available to attend/join all the CTBV EAG meetings and provide advice between meetings, if required
- Be able, flexible and prepared to contribute actively to the work of the CTBV EAG
- Be recognised by their peers as a leader in their field e.g. national academies and Royal Colleges

Essential Criteria

Lay Member

- Be a skilled communicator
- Be able to assimilate complex scientific information at short notice
- Be available to attend/join all the CTBV EAG meetings and provide advice between meetings, if required

Remuneration will be £200 per meeting, for a time commitment of up to 10 meetings per year. The MHRA determines the length of appointment, which will be one year initially with the possibility to extend to four years thereafter.
