Agenda item 2 - Update on question 1 work strands

The board discussed the level of analysis to consider (sector, occupation, localities), and the different measures of the severity of skills mismatches.

The board agreed:

- · to consider skills from an occupational perspective
- that measures of mismatch should cover both supply and demand of skills
- that it needs to have a functional and relevant skills taxonomy
