Whilst the majority of amendments have been minor, key changes to MAA 01 in this routine staffing round are:

- To better reflect the document's purpose a title change from Regulatory Policy to Regulatory Principles.
- A break out of Regulatory Notifications to Regulatory Instructions and Notices:

"To effect timely communication of regulatory changes, the MAA will employ one of 2 types of notification, dependent upon the nature of the information conveyed:

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- a. Regulatory Instruction (RI). A RI will be issued by the MAA to provide direction. RIs have the same authority as MAA regulation. Typical usage will include the promulgation of new or amended Regulation at short notice, or to provide authority for deferred compliance with new or amended Regulation. Amendment proposals relating to the content of RIs should be made via the RFC process and reference the 'parent' MRP document.
- b. Regulatory Notice (RN). A RN will notify changes in MAA owned process, or provide operational or engineering guidance. They may promulgate planned MAA activity and are administrative in nature. RNs do not constitute Regulatory requirements. Comments regarding the content of a RN should be directed to DSA-MAA-MRPEnquiries@mod.gov.uk." (Ch 4 Para 25)
- Update to the MAA and MRP Structures on Pgs 11 and 25 (including imminent publications).
- Insertion of EP where appropriate.
