## Revocation of the avian influenza Surveillance Zone near Sudbury, Babergh, South Suffolk centred on grid reference TL9079839922

- 1) The Secretary of State makes this declaration to revoke the surveillance zone that was declared at 14:30 on 20 January 2022 in accordance with articles 4(1)(e) and 36(3) of the Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals (England) (No 2) Order S.I. 2006/2702 (as amended).
- 2) This revocation takes effect from 19:00 on 26 January 2022, thereby ending the measures imposed in the 10 kilometre Surveillance Zone centred on grid reference TL9079839922 declared on 20 January 2022, which had replaced the original declaration of a protection and surveillance zone dated 8 December 2021.
