

Revocation of the avian influenza Surveillance Zone near Louth, East Lindsey, Lincolnshire centred on grid reference TF2915589473

- 1) The Secretary of State makes this declaration to revoke the surveillance zone that was declared at 19:00 on 28 February 2022 in accordance with articles 4(1)(e) and 36(3) of the Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals (England) (No 2) Order S.I. 2006/2702 (as amended).
- 2) This revocation takes effect from 11.00 on 28 March 2022, thereby ending the measures imposed in the 10 kilometre Surveillance Zone centred on grid reference TF2915589473 declared on 28 February 2022, which had replaced the original declaration of a protection and surveillance zone dated 31 December 2021.
