1) Defra Presentation

Defra presented on draft evidence and information relating to storm overflows provided by the Storm Overflows Evidence Project.

2) Discussion

Discussion between Defra and members of the Water Expert Advisory Group included the following topics:

- The feasibility of identifying priority areas for action on storm overflows.
- The potential influence of seasonal factors on the impact of storm overflows.
- The proposed metrics.
- The benefits of including both nitrogen and phosphorus in a target on wastewater discharges to waters.

A summary of the advice and discussion from the Water Expert Advisory Group has been incorporated into the Detailed Evidence Report which accompanies our Environment Act 2021: environmental targets. Work on storm overflows is being taken forward separately through a government plan which will set out our ambitions to tackle the harm caused by storm overflows.
