1) Defra Presentation

Defra presented on the proposed level of ambition for the water demand target and the metric.

2) Discussion

Experts presented on the different demands on public and non-public supply of water, and how climate change will impact upon this.

Discussion between Defra and members of the Water Expert Advisory Group included the following topics:

- The proposed water demand target metric.
- The increase in home working and potential resulting pressure on smaller local sewage treatment plants, septic tanks and water supply works.
- The evidence base used to assess non-consumptive water demand (where water is removed and later returned to the environment e.g. water used for industrial cooling).
- The relationship between the proposed target and the National Water Resources Framework recommendations on water demand.
- The benefits of using total household consumption rather than per capita consumption in the metric.
- How uncertainty over population growth could affect the target and projections for water demand.

A summary of the advice and discussion from the Water Expert Advisory Group has been incorporated into the Detailed Evidence Report which accompanies our Environment Act 2021: environmental targets.
