

Revocation of the avian influenza Residual Surveillance Zone near Tedburn St Mary, Teignbridge, Devon declared at 17.00 on 1 June 2022

- 1) The Secretary of State makes this declaration to revoke the surveillance zone that was declared at 17.00 on 1 June 2022 in accordance with articles 4(1)(e) and 36(3) of the Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals (England) (No 2) Order S.I. 2006/2702 (as amended).
- 2) This revocation takes effect from 17.00 on 9 June 2022, thereby ending the measures imposed in the Residual Surveillance Zone contained within the lens created by the intersection of a circle of radius 10 kilometres, centred on grid reference SX7993295625 and a circle of radius 10 kilometres, centred on grid reference SX8918997342 declared on 1 June 2022, which had replaced the original declaration of a surveillance zone dated 16 May 2022.
