# Grenfell Tower site update: summary of community online meeting

## Grenfell Tower site update: summary of community online meeting

At the online meeting on 7 June 2022, we updated attendees on:

- Maintenance and safety works at the tower, including the ongoing installation of 'props' (metal supports) in the basement
- How we monitor noise levels
- Contractor procurement
- Activities happening close to the site around the fifth anniversary of the Grenfell Tower tragedy, which DLUHC is supporting
- Completion of recent work to relocate a local electricity substation
- How to access the garages under the walkway blocks
