







Ips typographus Confirmed outbreak sites 10km grid summary

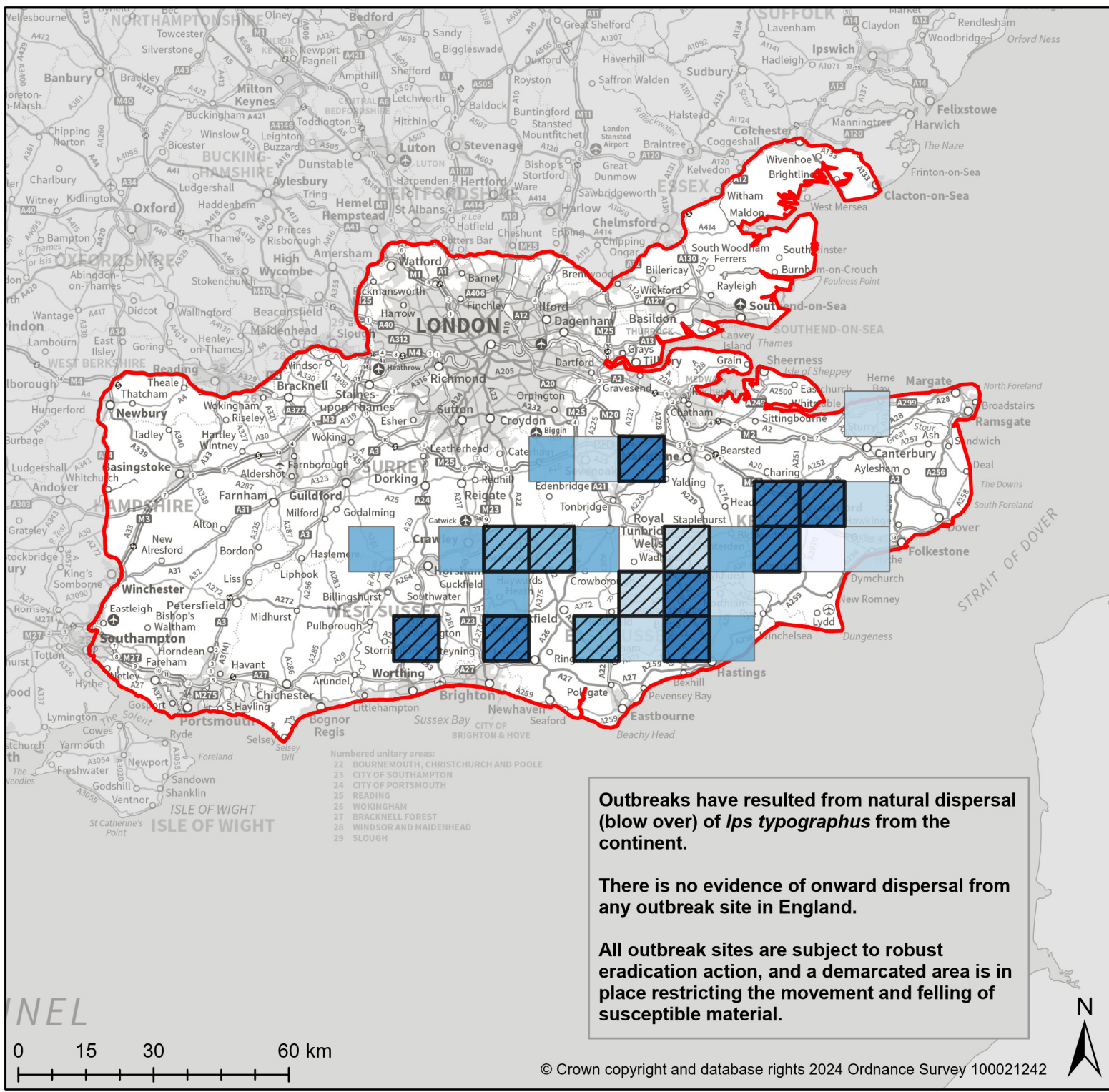

Outbreaks have resulted from natural dispersal (blow over) of *Ips typographus* from the continent.

There is no evidence of onward dispersal from any outbreak site in England.

All outbreak sites are subject to robust eradication action, and a demarcated area is in place restricting the movement and felling of susceptible material.

For privacy reasons outbreaks are mapped to the nearest 10km grid square to avoid revealing individual sites.
