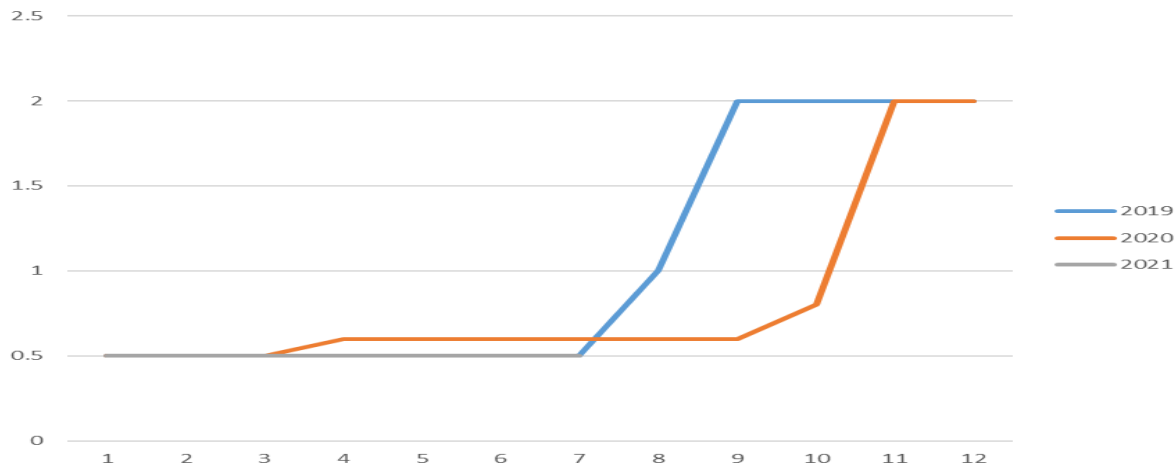

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Angler VII - Additional Quota

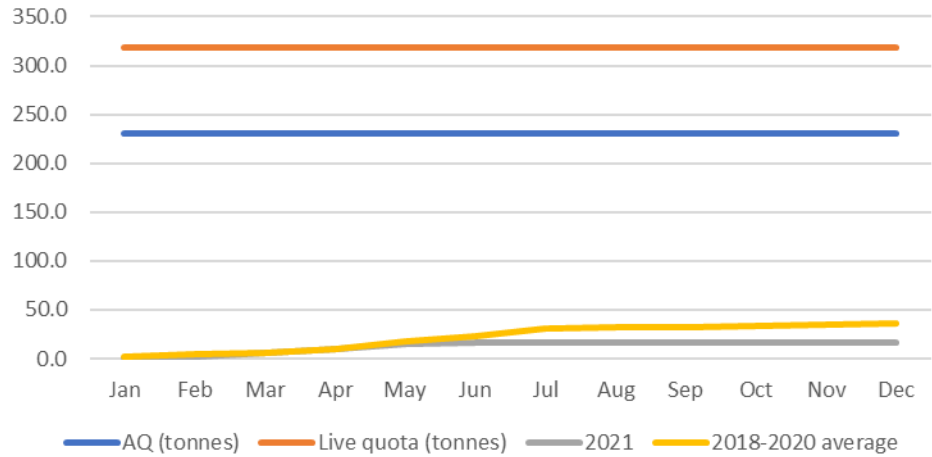


- Unlikely that the AQ will be used by any sector this year but use by the is Sector more likely than non-sector.

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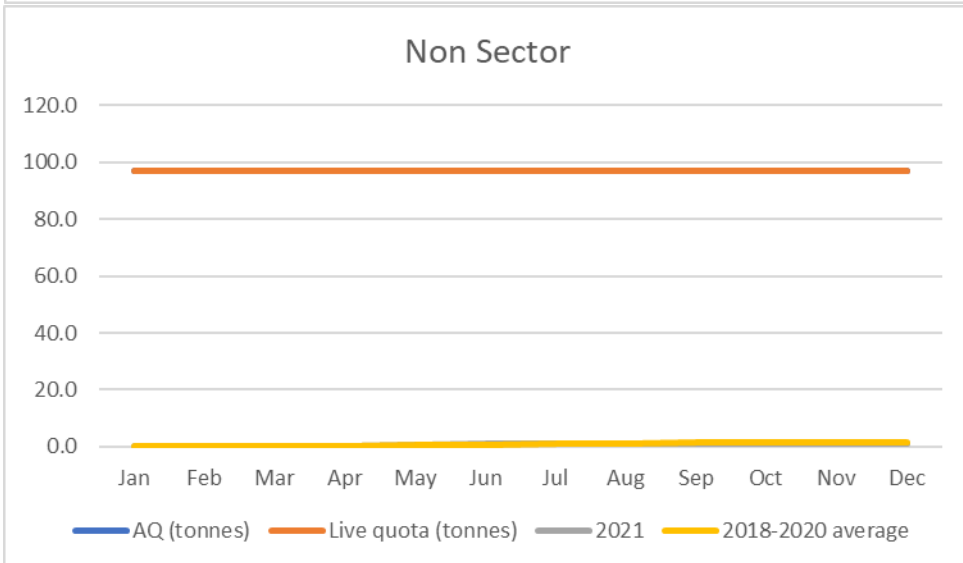
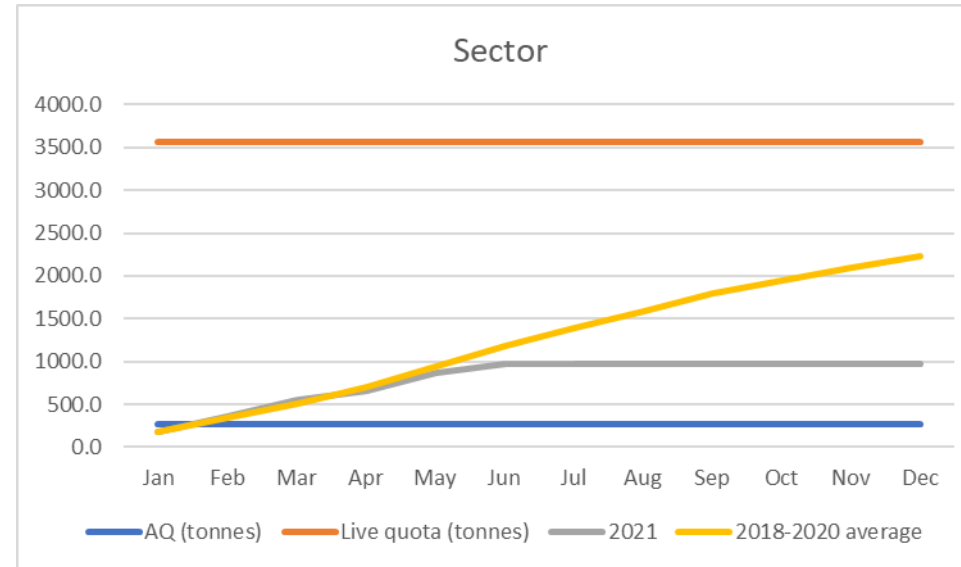
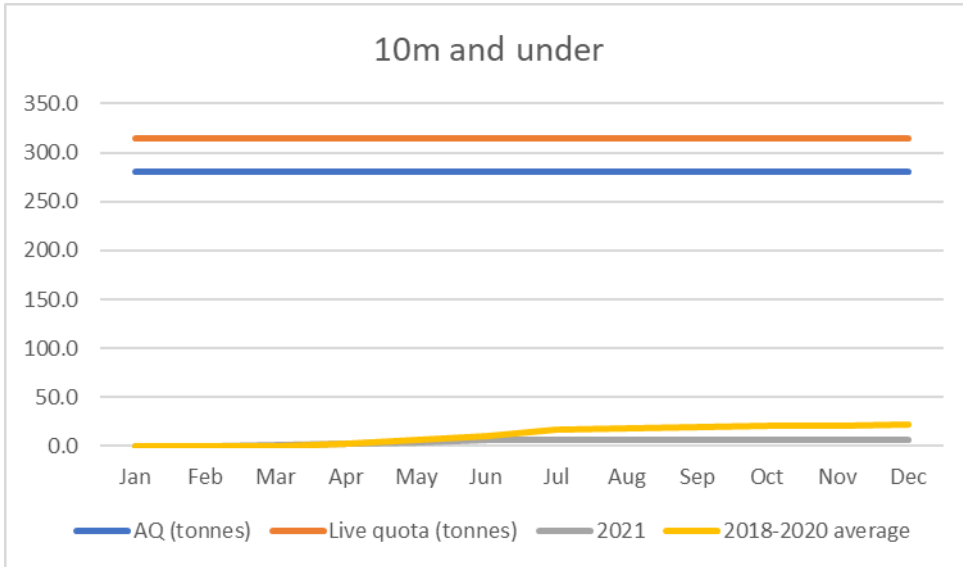
Whiting VIIb-k - Additional Quota

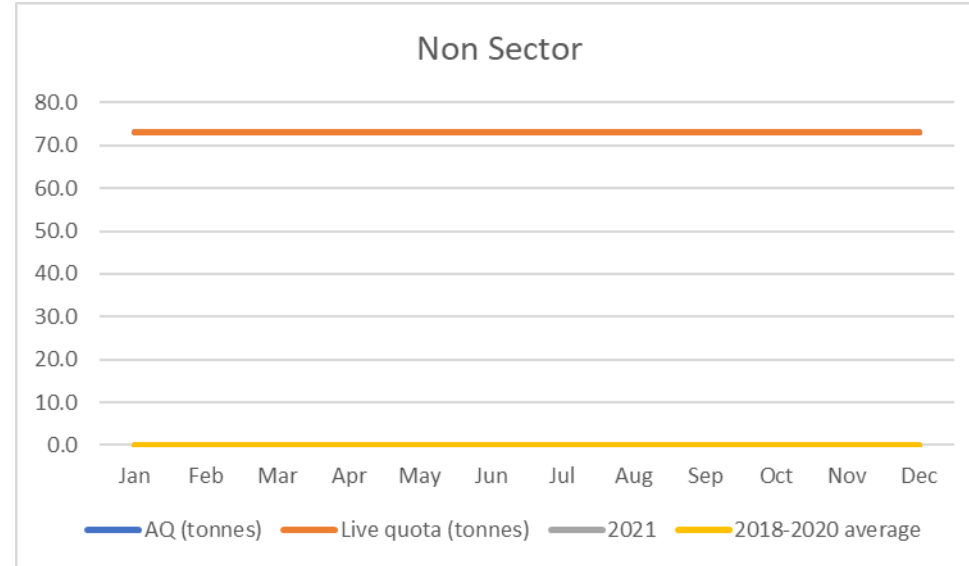
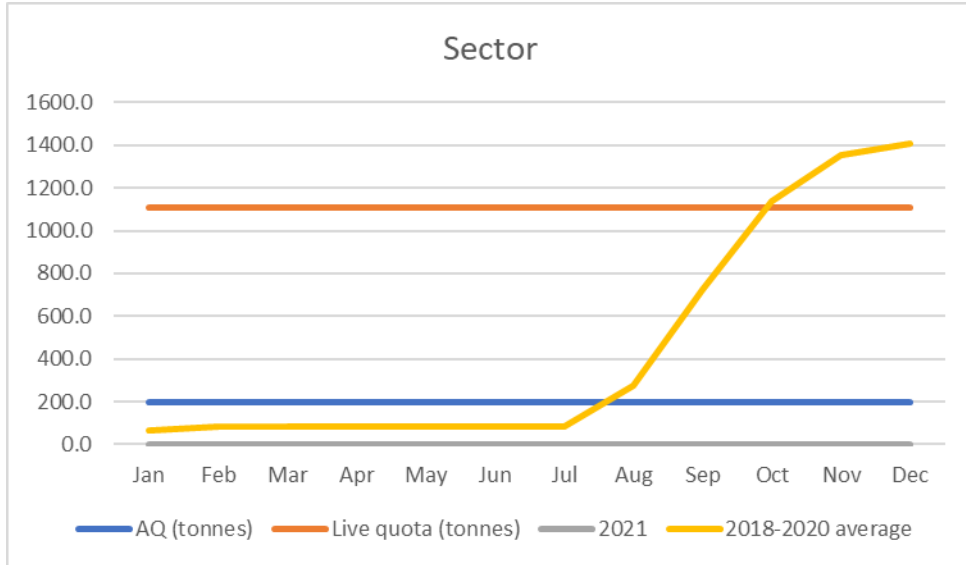
