Grenfell Tower site update:

Grenfell Tower site update: summary of community online meeting

At the online meeting on 5 July 2022, we updated attendees on:

- Maintenance and safety works at the tower, including the ongoing installation of 'props' (metal supports) in the basement
- How we monitor noise levels
- Completion of recent work to relocate a local electricity substation
- How to access the garages under the walkway blocks
- Local opportunities available from the Grenfell Tower site principal contractor, DUK. Recent examples include a £45,000 premises and equipment fund, recruitment of six local apprentices, refurbishment of a community kitchen, and local litter-picking, as well as upcoming job fairs. We also gave an update on:

- Ground investigation works at the Grenfell Tower site, due to start on 8 August. Analysing the ground around the tower is part of the government's responsibility for the site. The works will involve drilling some holes in the ground outside the tower to provide DLUHC with information about the condition of the ground around the basement, which will be helpful ahead of any decisions being made about the future of the tower and the site. No decision has yet been made about the future of the tower's future is made
- Asbestos-removal in Grenfell Tower, which you can read more about here
- Procuring a replacement contractor for local air monitoring, which is carried out regularly around the tower to provide reassurance to the local community. You can see this month's monitoring results on <u>GOV.UK</u>
