Veterans can apply for a badge if you served in the Women's Land Army or Timber Corps at any time until the corps were disbanded in 1950, and a record of service can be established.

You can also apply for a badge if you are the spouse or family member of a deceased veteran, but only if they died after 6 December 2007, when the badge was issued.
