#### **Background**

Following recent issues around the accurate recording of public and private match-funding contributions, the table below sets out which match-funding sources should be classified as public match-funding and which funding sources should be classified as private match-funding sources.

This is to ensure full alignment with the ESIF ECLAIMS system used to administer ESF funding and also support compliance with EU Commission requirements on reporting public funding contributions.
