Revocation of an Avian Influenza Prevention Zone (England)

The Secretary of State has carried out a further risk assessment under article 6(1) of the Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals (England) (No 2) Order 2006 (as amended) (“the Order”) and declares that the Avian Influenza Prevention Zone that was made on 29 April 2022 and has applied in the whole of England since 00.01 on 2 May 2022 is hereby formally revoked in accordance with article 4(1)(e) of the Order at 12.00 on 16 August 2022.
