The reason for my objection is as follows:

My sister and her husband live close to the planned development. They often walk or exercise close to their home (and we often visit to enjoy the open spaces with them). If this large development goes ahead, not only will the natural beauty of the area be spoiled, but these pathways will become narrow corridors with view of industrial equipment, or permanently inaccessible.

The site is not flat, so is not suitable for a solar farm, which will be impossible to 'hide', plus the scheme will not contribute to the energy needs of the local community.

Please halt the development of this scheme.
