Dear Mr. Trevillan,

I am writing to object to the above application on land adjacent to Ginns Road, Berden on the grounds that industrial solar farms are not the correct solution to address climate change. I understand the need to address climate change and support offshore wind farms which have less affect on local environments and communities. I also believe there are more suitable "brown sites" for solar farms.

The land proposed for the solar farm is put to great use agriculturally and the need for the UK to become for self sufficient is clearly evident. Using this land for a solar farm is wasteful and will cause great disruption to local wildlife.

The network road structure around the proposed solar farm is totally unsuitable for the construction traffic which would be required. This will create a huge safety risk.

In conclusion I have many reasons this application should be refused.
