The reason for my objections are as follows

The scale of the development is simply too big and not in line with Uttlesford policy of small scale renewable energy provided it will not effect sensitive landscapes ,nature conservation and residential and recreational amenities. This development will clearly effect all three of these .

I am a keen walker and I dont want to walk through a huge solar industrial estate . There are many footpaths and bridle ways for many miles running through this proposed site .

The site is rich in wild life with a number red listed species . It is also prime agricultural land which goes directly against central government policy to protect agricultural land from such developments

There will be an enormous visual impact on the entire local area and small villages . Its just not proportionate or appropriate in this beautiful rural area to have a Dutch company knowing nothing about the area making an application for an enormous industrial site for out of date solar panels
