The reason for my objection is as follows:

Uttlesford council has already sufficient ground mounted solar power to 132% of their households, and local plans going forward to increase this to 52,000. Solar farms should not be built in the countryside, these should be used on commercial roof space or brown field sites. This proposed site aims to include 100,068 solar panels which again should have no place in our countryside. The sheer scale of this proposal will bring continued chaos on our local road networks.
