I am writing to object to the proposal by Statera to construct a solar farm on 177 acres of land at Berden Hall Farm.

The reason for my objection is as follows:

- 1. Productive farm land should be used for growing the crops we need for food security.**
- 2. Uttlesford already has sufficient ground mounted solar to power 132% of their households**

- 4. Solar farms do not need to be built in the countryside they can go on commercial roof space**
