I have no problem with solar installations in the UK - in fact I support them - but I am objecting to this proposal on 3 counts.

- 1) the size - yes we should be installing solar across the UK but not in the scale proposed. 177 acres is just too big.
- 2) it's location is not only good agricultural land but also has poor access. I don't understand how they intend to get the solar panels and battery on site.
- 3) there is no specific benefit to the local user. Surely if you are installing these large solar facilities there should be a benefit to the local community
