Objections

- Elsenham has almost doubled in size in recent years and this proposal would be too much development added onto a village which has already taken more than its fair share of new housing developments.
- This is one of the last remaining open spaces in Elsenham and should not be destroyed for yet more houses.
- Weaknesses with this location:
 - within a water stressed area
 - capacity of the local road network
 - o impact on the character of nearby villages
 - o loss of agricultural land
 - o presence of protected species in the vicinity
- The access roads which serve Elsenham and Henham are winding country lanes with inadequate widths and junctions. The road system is wholly unsuitable for further new houses.
- The countryside setting around Elsenham and Henham would be destroyed by this
 development; pleasant landscape would be lost forever.
