I wish to object to the above planning application for the following reasons,

I live on the route between Elsenham and Stansted and am constantly plagued by traffic waiting to go down Grove Hill, Stansted. The noise and exhaust pollution become very noticeable during these periods, and quite frankly a danger to health for the residents.

Although the volume of domestic traffic is unacceptable this is exasperated by heavy lorries using Grove Hill and Elsenham Road often causing major problems.

The rest of the village of Stansted is subsequentially disrupted and totally gridlocked at times.

It is extremely dangerous to walk the footpath on Elsenham Road as two lorries cannot pass each other without mounting the pavement and often use the apron to my drive to enable passing.

Most of these lorries are moving soil from one site to another their gross weight is 32 Tonnes and are destroying the roads in this area.

Elsenham is now substantially overdeveloped and what with all the sites that have been accepted but not yet developed this site is the only green space left. The infrastructure of this whole area is not adequate and will soon collapse leaving residents stranded.

Therefore, this application MUST NOT BE ACCEPTED.
