Planning objection to 130 houses on land south of Henham Road Ref: planning S62A/22/007

Please note our objection to the application on the follow grounds.

Elsenham is losing green belt areas at an alarming rate. Already 350+ houses being built north of Henham Road on valuable green belt fields.

No infrastructure investment in terms of utilities, drainage/sewage. They just join into the existing one. Station road has issues of flooding when heavy rain causes sewage and flooding where builders have joined into a sewer that is not adequate. This is an example of poor/ lack of forward thinking and investment.

Henham road opposite the proposed development is in grid lock. everyday when children are being dropped off and picked up at the village primary school. The school is at capacity now with no places available! This will mean more cars traveling to take children to other schools.

Grove Hill in Stansted is in appalling state of repair. Mornings and evenings in grid lock with huge numbers of vehicles. Hall road is narrow in places, being the only appropriate HGV access to the village. I have had several near misses with HGVs over the last few months.

Over the last few years in excess of 1000 houses have been or are being built, in Elsenham.

Enough is Enough!

Waiting times at our local Stansted Doctors surgery is ridiculous. Personally, I'm waiting to see a doctor for a follow up visit, I've been given an appointment in 7 weeks time! With 350+ being built and another 130 proposed houses will push local services beyond breaking point!
