Grenfell Tower site update: summary of community online meeting

Grenfell Tower site update: summary of community online meeting

At the online meeting on 4 October 2022, we updated attendees on:

- Maintenance and safety works at the tower, including completing the installation of 'props' (metal supports) in the basement
- Lancaster West Estate residents can access the garages under the walkway blocks by contacting the site management team using the contact details at the end of this summary
- The next phase of the refurbishment of the Lancaster West Estate is scheduled to start later this year
- Completion of ground investigation works at the Grenfell Tower site, which will tell us about the condition of the ground around the tower
- No decision has yet been made about the future of the tower and further conversations need to take place before a decision on the tower's future is made
- Completion of asbestos removal in Grenfell Tower. You can read more about the asbestos removal on [GOV.UK](https://www.gov.uk)
- Procuring a replacement contractor for local air monitoring, which is carried out regularly around the tower to provide reassurance to the local community.
