

NOTES - MATERIALS

Slate roof finish to match main house with matching slate ridge tile

Hi level roof light to be metal conservation type

General external wall to be facing brickwork in bricks to match main house. All openings to have either curved / straight facing brick soldier course over and reconstituted stone cills. Facing brickwork plinth up to DPC level through out.

Two courses of facing brickwork corbels as shadow course under gable barge board.

Barge board and eaves detail to be timber and painted.

All windows to be purpose made traditional timber box sash with Ogee or Torus leading edge detail and complete with all associated weight boxes.

All external doors to be timber and prepared for paint finish.

All feature brickwork including quoins, string and lintel courses to match each other and to be laid in lime mortar with flush pointing

Aluminium rainwater goods using Ogee gutter sections with powder coated finish
