I write to you express my objection and concern about the plans to build these additional houses in Elsenham.

Elsenham and Henham are already above capacity for what they can serve in terms of safety, facilities, traffic, green space and education.

Plans for fewer houses for the area has been previously refused based on it not being suitable. This should speak volumes in itself. This application would take the number of houses in the area being built to a larger number than was previously rejected.

We do not have the infrastructure to support these houses. Journey times have already, at least, doubled for residents with the houses already added to the area.

I am also constantly getting people to get in my car when driving along the local roads as there are no pavements or easy modes of transport so people are walking along the dangerous roads and putting lives at risk!

The area's roads have also suffered emensly with the increased traffic with verges damaged, dangerous pot holes and damaged property. This is due to continous works, road closures and the huge number of cars using these roads.

People have chosen to live in this area to benefit from the countryside and quality of life that comes with it. Most of us have paid a premium to have this. Building these additional houses is jeopardising the whole area, both environmentally (e.g. wildlife, farming, trees, water etc etc) and the quality of living.
