Dear Planning Inspectorate,

I WISH TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING OBSERVATIONS AND COMMENTS REGARDING THE ABOVE DEVELOPMENT PROPOSAL.

- 1). Henham village has been affected by several new housing developments which has considerably increased the village population, added many more residents vehicle movements leaving and entering the village and severe congestion on Grove Hill and Chapel Hill in Stansted Mountfitchet. These two roads are badly affected by 'on street' parking restricting the road to single lane vehicle movement.
- 2). A further 200 homes in Elsenham will lead to 100/200 more vehicles using the B adding to the traffic flow through Stansted.
- 3). Previous Planning Applications have been rejected by the Secretary of State on the grounds of SUSTAINABILITY. Nothing has changed in regard to this proposed development.
- 4). Elsenham village will likewise be affected by further traffic congestion resulting in a reduced 'quality of life' for the residents of Henham, Elsenham and Stansted Mountfitchet.

It is my opinion, based on the logical issues I have quoted, that this additional Bloor Homes proposed development should be similarly REJECTED.
