I would like to object, very strongly, to the above proposed development of even more houses in a very poorly sustainable site.

There has already been so much development in this area that the local roads are far too busy. To get into our nearest town, Bishops Stortford, at busy times takes at least ten minutes longer than it did not even five years ago. Stansted Mountfitchet cannot take any more traffic from Elsenham and Henham

I wonder how 800 dwellings are not sustainable but that the developments, here and there around Elsenham and Henham already allowed or applied for are for over 1000 dwellings. That makes NO SENSE AT ALL. Especially as the Secretary of State said this was not to be allowed.

The developer says that Elsenham and Henham have excellent public transport facilities, the buses are limited and the residents have to use our MINOR roads mostly.

The land around these villages is PRIME AGRICULTURAL LAND, and should be used as such.
