I write to you in respect of the above address. This site already has 350 homes approved for Bloor Homes to build on Grade 1 & Grade 2 productive agricultural land, and now I understand that an application for a further 200 homes to be built has been submitted.

Please STOP, just STOP this application!

Elsenham is a small quaint village, and NOT A TOWN! Stop trying to turn a profit by turning it in to a town! Being a village it has limited amenities, which are shared by, and enjoyed by all...but these resources are already very stretched... such as the Drs, and there is already very limited parking (such as by the post office and our local Tesco shop).

The roads themselves cannot cope as it is. The roads are narrow, and already have several potholes, and in poor overall condition, and many roads don't even have a pavement! The roads leading in and out of Elsenham have become dangerous due to the increased traffic and causeds traffic chaos...even on a good day.

Please do not allow our village to become a town. We do NOT need, and do NOT want these extra houses! We moved to a village, for the village life, and fresh air...and you will be taking that away. Our quality of life will be diminished, and it will not be a pleasant place to live much longer.
