Dear sirs

I wish to lodge my objections to the application by Bloor Homes to build an additional 200 homes between Henham and Elsenham villages, in excess of the 350 homes that are currently approved.

Amongst my objections are:

- in 2016 an application for 800 homes on the same sites was refused planning - how can it now be acceptable?
- the roads between Henham, Elsenham and Stansted are not suitable for such a large development.
- the delays for drivers at Grove Hill, Lower Street and Chapel Hill Stansted are already unacceptable and have been for several years
- the rural roads around the area are not suitable for a massive increase in traffic; the road surfaces are constantly damaged
- the primary school in Elsenham is already full - where / how will new families be able to educate their children in the local area
- there simply is not the range of facilities in the area to cater for such a large development

I do have several other objections not listed above however for speed keep it brief.

I wish my objections to be noted.
