I think this planning application is totally not needed.

Henham, Elsenham and Stansted Mountfitchet already have sufficient levels of housing for local demand. The infrastructure is not capable of supporting more housing - schools are over-subscribed, the doctors' lists are full and the local roads congested. Train services to London and Cambridge are sporadic at best.

Chapel Hill cannot take any more traffic - the road surface is appalling, due to the number of vehicles using it. Developers say the transport links are excellent, quite frankly they are not. We are close to the A120 and M11, however, the roads to these major roads are congested and in appalling condition. To think of bringing in hundreds of new residents, who will have to have cars, is not acceptable.

Previous applications for new hundreds of new homes have been turned down, therefore it simply cannot be acceptable for this application to proceed.

I would appreciate confirmation of receipt of this email and to be kept updated as the application proceeds.
