Dear Sirs

I am writing to voice my concerns to yet another proposed development in the local area. There has been a substantial amount of development already and there is a lot more development due that has been already been agreed.

The local roads just cannot accommodate any more traffic. The roads are all narrow and quite dangerous and with the amount of large lorries that now frequent them a danger. I am frequently pushed over on to the grass verge to avoid a collision and there are large ruts and holes at the side of all the roads. There were two fatalities recently on a local road near to Elsenham and Henham.

The problems at Grove Hill and Chapel Hill continue to be an ongoing concern and the traffic is often backed up as people try to negotiate the lights. A lot of traffic now uses Ugley to avoid the lights and that road is narrow, winding and has some blind right angle corners. There is no footpath for pedestrians and of course there is no street lighting along any of the local roads.

I strongly oppose any more development in the vicinity as the whole local community have accommodated more than their fair share of housing compared to nationally.
