Please count this email as my very strong objection to this unacceptable development.

To lose agricultural land for yet more houses, in an area that is already suffering with congestion, in roads and lanes that were never designed for the volume of traffic that now travels through, is in my opinion completely unacceptable. The school run from Henham, through Stansted Mountfitchet, takes over an hour to reach Bishop Stortford because of the current congestion. This pollutes the atmosphere and is destroying the village. There are regularly dead deer and other local wildlife species, not to mention pets, killed in the local roads due to the volume and speed of traffic passing through them.

The plan for 800 houses was refused as unsustainable, so how can more than 800 houses achieved in separate developments be acceptable?
This application must be refused and any further applications of this nature.
