UK vessels intending to operate outside British Fishery Limits must have an external waters licence in addition to their base domestic licence.

#### You can use this form if you are:

- applying to fish in Norwegian exclusive economic zone (EEZ) waters between 12 and 200 nautical miles (or agreed maritime boundaries)
- applying to fish in the fisheries protection zone around Svalbard.

#### Before you start:

- you will need the vessel details
- you will need to provide owner of vessel details
- you will need to provide details of any nominees

We will aim to action your change within 10 working days.
