<p>An area of open moorland containing a small arms range and resulting Danger Area on Cardinham Moor, Bodmin Moor.</p>

<b>8. DESCRIPTION OF MILITARY USE:</b>			
<p>Millpool Range is used for live small arms firing. It has an associated Danger Area. The range itself is fenced and signed with warning notices. The Danger Area is unfenced but marked with warning signs and MOD standard red/white Danger Poles.</p>			
<b>9. CURRENT PUBLIC ACCESS:</b>			
<p>There are numerous footpaths traversing Millpool Danger Area. Public access is managed during live firing by Range staff and red flags. Permissive open access on foot is available when the red flags are not displayed.</p> <p>The area features common land and the Commoners have signed an agreement not to go within the RDA when live firing is taking place. MOD informs the Commoners when firing is taking place to enable them to move stock from the RDA before firing starts.</p> <p>This Direction will not affect existing public access, Commoner access rights, nor permissive access opportunities.</p>
