DIO have not conducted an Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) survey for this area. The Head of Establishment cannot guarantee public safety under Open Access rights across this land. - The s28 direction area is currently within the Woodbridge Station military training estate. In close proximity to the site is a disused ammunition storage area. This storage area is used for military training classed as dangerous: demolition of explosives and new CBRN training.
