Despite how happy we are in our home, we have endured numerous issues since our time here in relation to water pressure, and frequent drain issues. There have been several occasions of access issues when other homes have undergone low level restoration or building works, which has also had a detrimental impact on the surrounding grounds and roads. The magnitude of the above planning application has caused immense distress to both me and my family and what this may hold for our future here in Little Canfield. As well as the destruction to agricultural/forestry land, on top of the devastation to nature and wildlife, the building work in general will carry a mass of both noise and air pollution that will continue for quite some time. This in turn will bring an overload of residents to an already very stretched area increasing the water and drainage issues that already carry a burden to the area and have done for many years. High Cross Lane is a single file road that is not suitable for large vehicles. Access to this would cause an immense load of disruption.

I cannot stress enough the worry and distress I personally am feeling in anticipation for the above taking place. I would like to please ask you to reconsider the above application and what this will mean for the surrounding residents and their families.
