I am writing to object most strongly to the planning application referenced above.

High Cross Lane and local infrastructure is already overloaded due to the recent and ongoing housing developments.

High Cross Lane is a single track road with increased traffic flow causing terrible damage to the verges and collapse of drainage ditches resulting in increased flooding.

Increased light pollution and activity from the already increased housing on High Cross Lane is having a detrimental effect on local wildlife especially to the owl and buzzard population.

We are also seeing increased use of High Cross Lane by walkers and cyclists including children and dog walkers and with no footpaths which obviously creates a real safety hazard as vehicle traffic flow increases.
