OFFER OF APPOINTMENT: INTERIM CHAIR OF THE OFFICE FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT

I am delighted to confirm your appointment as Interim Chair of the Office for Local Government. The Levelling Up White Paper announced the establishment of a new local government data body. It is important that devolution is accompanied by enhanced accountability. - 3. Provide visible, public facing leadership to the new organisation and lead a comprehensive programme of engagement with the sector to promote the work of Oflog and understand the perspectives of its service users.

In exercising your duties, any advice you provide will be communicated through the established governance and reporting mechanisms of the new organisation and/or Department as required. You will exercise your duties at all times in accordance with the Nolan Report Recommendations, 'The Seven Principles of Public Life'.

Your appointment will be for a period of 18 months commencing on 25 January 2023 and ending on 25 July 2024, unless terminated before that date.
