Given that the site is on a hill this action is likely make a significant impact on the targets in the travel plan.

Car club

Provision of 2 car club electric vehicle parking spaces
Pump prime for 1 vehicle for 5 years = £8667 x 5 =£43,335
Driving credit 10 hours per dwelling = £80 per dwelling
Annual Membership = £60 for 5 years = £300 per dwelling
