THE IMPORTATION OF ANIMALS ORDER 1977 (ARTICLE 3 (2))

THE ANIMALS (POST-IMPORT CONTROL) ORDER 1995

In respect of the following General Import licence listed below:

IMP/GEN/2014/09 –Imports of cattle for breeding and production from the Channel Islands.

Condition 4 has been further amended with regards to Jersey's Brucellosis, Tuberculosis (bTB) and Enzootic Bovine Leukosis (EBL) freedom status to read:

Jersey is currently free of EBL, bovine tuberculosis and bovine brucellosis therefore imports of cattle from the Island are **NOT** required to be tested for these diseases.

All other conditions remain unchanged.

Note: Cattle imported from Guernsey **MUST** be tested for diseases listed in point 4 of this licence including EBL.
