Appointment as Local Government and Social Care Ombudsman

I am delighted to confirm your appointment by His Majesty the King as Commissioner for Local Administration. Your appointment will be for a period of 6 months commencing on 1 April 2023 and ending on 31 September 2023, unless terminated before that date.

I am also delighted to confirm that the Secretary of State for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 23(7) of the Local Government Act 1974, has designated you as the Chair of the Commission for Local Administration in England ("the Commission") with effect from 1 April 2023. As Chair, you will also commonly be known as the Local Government and Social Care Ombudsman.

Through the Levelling Up and Regeneration Bill the Government is transferring more power and responsibility to local government, which makes it increasingly vital that local citizens have an effective right of redress where local services do not meet the standards that the public rightly expect and deserve.

As Ombudsman, you will play a vital role in this framework for redress. Your investigations will help remedy serious injustice suffered by members of the public and will improve local outcomes for communities across the country. Your job, in essence, is to "put things right when they have gone wrong" for ordinary citizens.

Your appointment is made on the basis that you have no conflicts of interest in taking up this role, beyond those already disclosed to the Department. Should any potential conflict of interest arise in

the future, you must notify both the Department and the Commission in writing and be prepared to step aside from decisions on which you are conflicted.
