This letter confirms the amount of delegated Adult Education Budget (AEB) you will receive in the financial year (FY) 2023-24 (1 April 2023 to 31 March 2024) to deliver relevant adult education functions in your delegated area.

Your total delegated AEB for FY 2023-24 is set out in the table in Annex A and will be paid by mid-April 2023.

We are providing this grant as a non-ring-fenced transfer under Section 39A of the Greater London Authority Act 1999 and have copied this grant letter to the Chief Finance Officer of the Greater London Authority for information.

The delegation letter¹ agreed between you and the Secretary of State sets out what assurances should be in place when carrying out the adult education functions.

The Department for Education also has an associated Memorandum of Understanding in place with you in relation to the devolution of adult education functions.

Notes:

1. This is not the overall total for FY 2024-25, which will include an amount from the academic year (AY) 2024/25. This will be confirmed in January 2024 and will be issued under a separate S31 Grant Determination Letter.
2. All amounts include additional funding awarded at Budget 2023, to support the delivery of Sector Based Work Academy growth. This has been allocated according to the existing AEB formula, resulting in an extra £3.36m for devolved areas in FY 23-24.
3. The Combined Authorities grant allocations will be transferred under separate arrangements in accordance with Section 31 of the Local Government Act 2003. They are being referenced here for completeness.
