**Re: Grant Determination Letter for Devolution of the Adult Education Budget for Financial Year 2022-23 – Additional Funding (DfE Grant Reference: AEBDEVO-22-23)**

This Determination is made between:

- (1) **The Secretary of State for Education** and
- (2) **The Mayor of London**

This letter confirms the additional amount of delegated Adult Education Budget (AEB) you will receive in the financial year (FY) 2022-23 for the period 1 August 2022 to 31 March 2023 to deliver relevant adult education functions in your delegated area.

#### Payment arrangements

Your additional delegated AEB for the period 1 August 2022 to 31 March 2023 is set out in the table in Annex A and will be paid by mid-March 2023.

We are making this additional payment because we are changing the basis on which we calculate your budget across academic and financial years as follows:

	<b>Current</b>	<b>New – with effect from 1 August 2022</b>	<b>Difference</b>
1 August 2022 – 31 March 2023	62.35%	66.67%	+4.02%
1 April – 31 July 2023	37.35%	33.33%	-4.02%

This additional payment brings forward 4.02% of the payment due to you in respect of the period 1 April to 31 July 2023 from the 2023-24 FY to the 2022-23 FY (see letter of March 2022 [here](#)). The amount due to be paid to you in April 2023 in respect of the period 1 April to 31 July 2023, as notified in March 2022, will be reduced by a corresponding 4.02%. The amount you shall receive for the 2022/23 academic year remains unchanged overall.

We are providing this grant as a non-ring-fenced transfer under Section 39A of the Greater London Authority Act 1999 and have copied this grant letter to the Chief Finance Officer of the Greater London Authority for information.

### Assurance arrangements

The delegation letter<sup>1</sup> agreed between you and the Secretary of State sets out the conditions on the exercise of these functions.

The Department for Education also has an associated Memorandum of Understanding in place with you in relation to the devolution of adult education functions.
