To Whom It May Concern,

I am a resident of Great Hallingbury, not far from the proposed site in this planning application. I strongly object to this site and frankly can not see any situation where it can be approved. These are some of the reasons:

- I have grave concerns regarding safety of pedestrians. This is only a small country road which has a lot of people that walk along it (there are no pavements). Adding regular HGVs will significantly increase the risk to these pedestrians.
- The poor residents right opposite and alongside the site will have a huge amount of noise pollution.
- The environmental impact to the area will be huge, affecting the local wildlife. In fact, they have already cleared much of the land - prior to getting any planning permission!! We should aim to protect these areas as much as we can.
- Furthermore - removal of further green land, trees, shrubs etc and replacing with concrete structures will further increase risk of flooding during heavy rains. Our country road already gets very flooded during heavy rains.
